Spring Term You and Diversity	Subject Content / Knowledge	To understand and respect diversity in society including race, sexuality, wealth, subcultures, and ability.
	Skills	To empathise with the feelings of others; to advocate respectful attitudes to all members of British society.
	Assessment	A written interim and final assessment piece exploring the benefits of diversity to British society and globally.
Summer Term You and Your Environment	Subject Content / Knowledge	To realise the personal responsibility in caring for our local, national and global environment.
	Skills	Active citizenship; advocating responsible behaviours; designing strategies to improve the environment.
	Assessment	A written interim and final assessment piece to demonstrate positive responsible attitudes towards stewardship.
